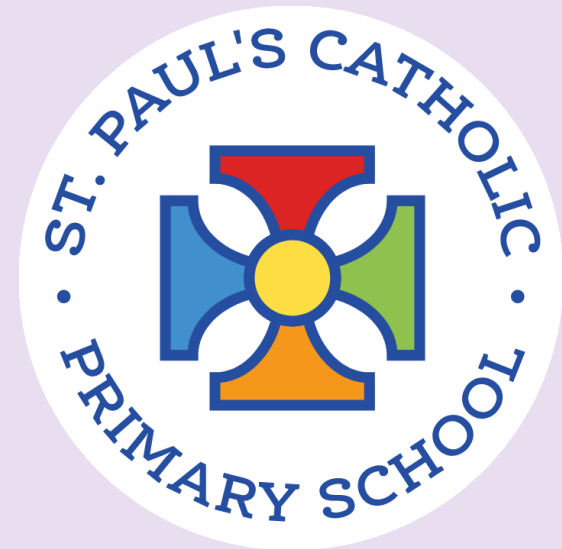


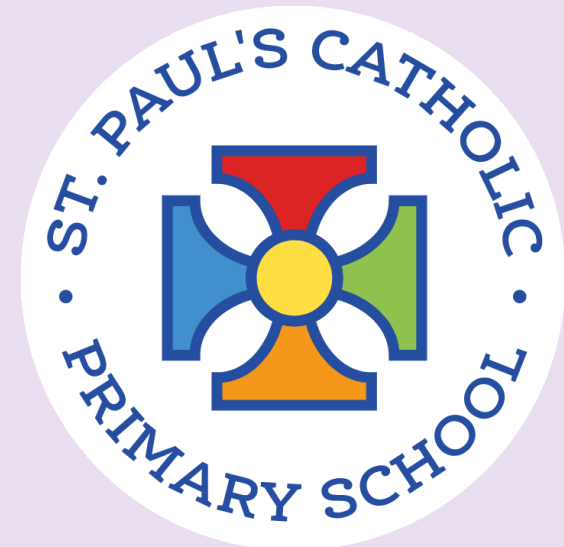

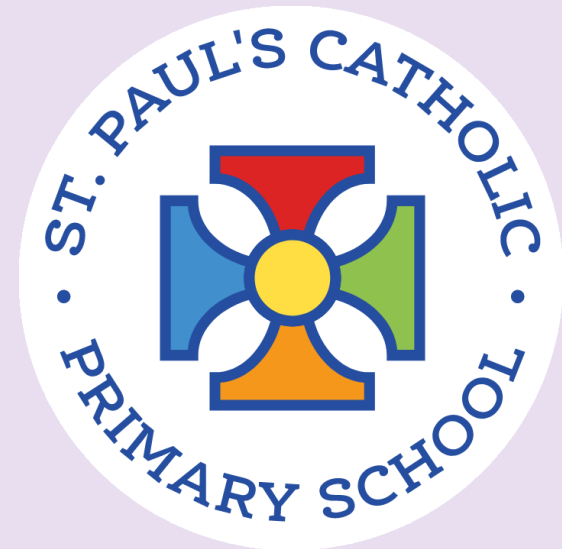
Unless a grain of wheat shall fall

If anyone serves me then they must follow me; wherever I am my servants will be.



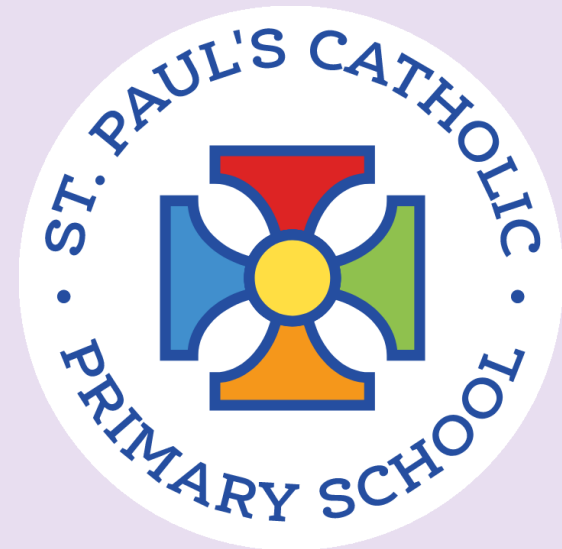

Hosanna in the highest.

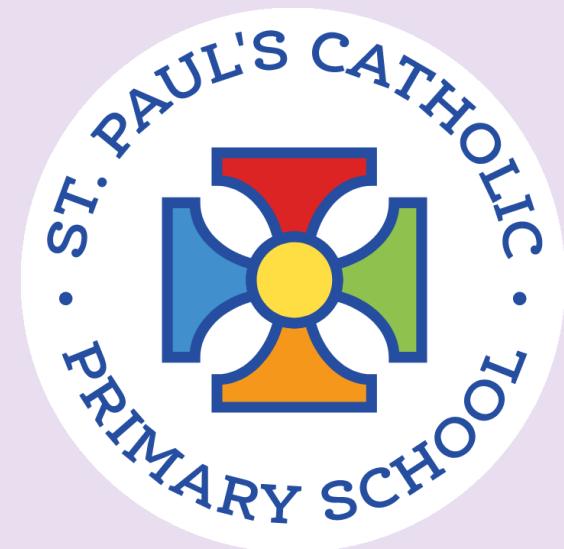


Priest :You are indeed Holy, O Lord,

and gave it to his disciples, saying:

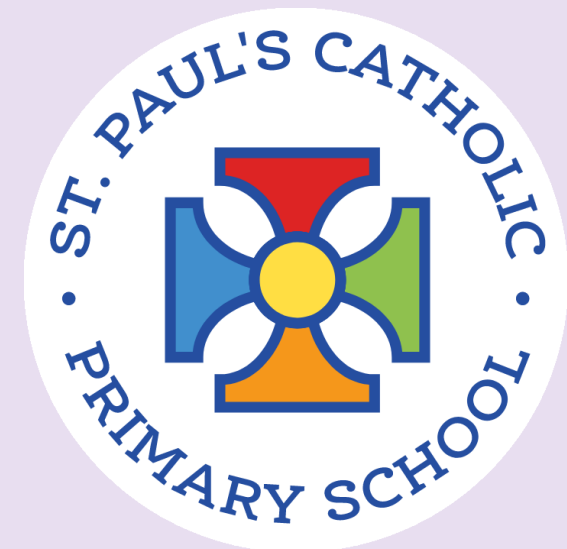


TAKE THIS, ALL OF YOU, AND EAT OF IT,

he gave it to his disciples, saying:

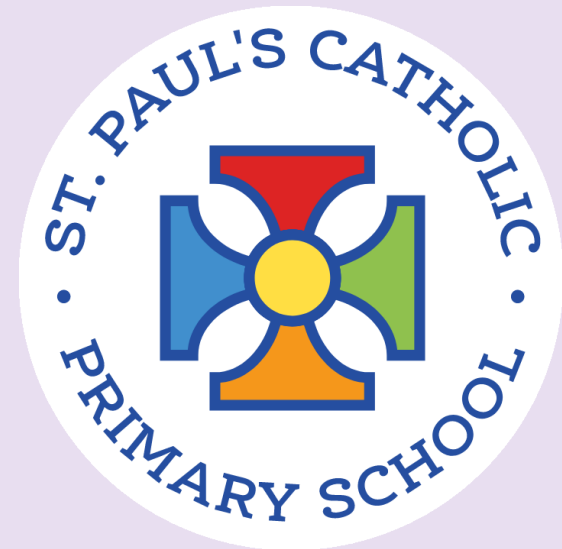


TAKE THIS, ALL OF YOU, AND DRINK FROM IT,

DO THIS IN MEMORY OF ME.



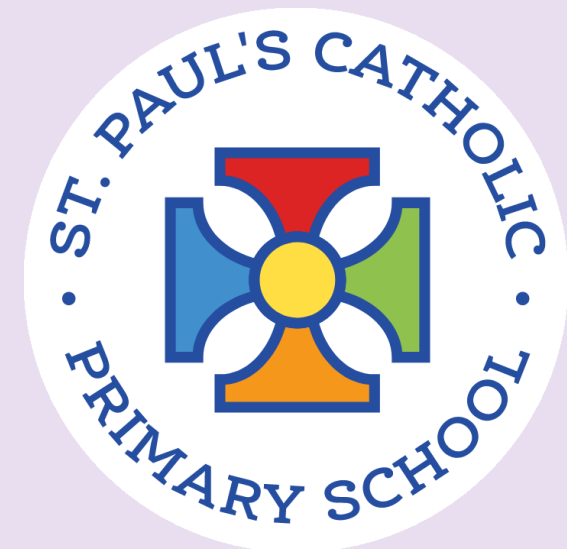
The mystery of faith.

you have set us free.

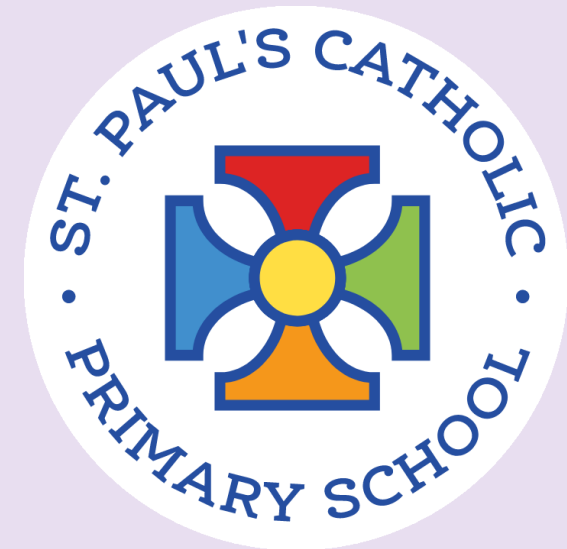

and the coming of our Saviour, Jesus Christ.

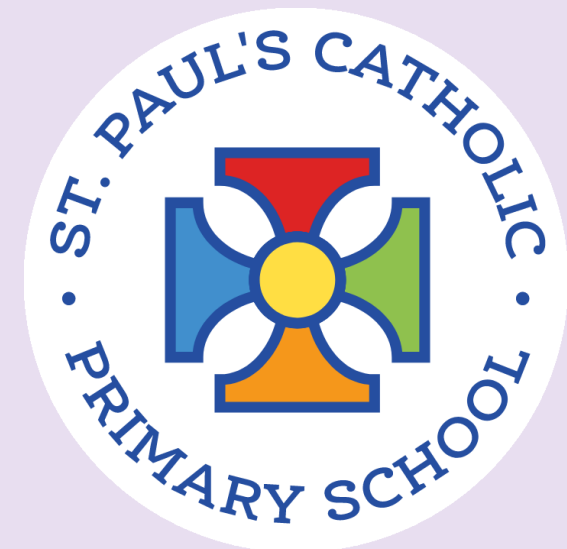
