




Year 4 Curriculum Overview: Autumn Term 2021



Creative Curriculum:

We will be exploring the world around us and will be comparing England to Brazil. We will explore Brazilian traditions and find out about the landscape to help us make comparisons. We will use the Amazon rainforest as a focus for our Art and colour mixing.

Children will be tested on their spellings every Friday.

Homework expectations:

Homework will be set on a Monday and collected in on a Friday. Every week, children will receive one piece of Maths and one piece of English alongside 0-12 spellings. There is an expectation your child will complete all home learning otherwise they will stay in on Friday lunchtimes to complete it.

Reading records will also be checked on a Friday. We expect the children to read a minimum of 3 nights to an adult. Children with 3 adult signatures will be entered into the raffle prize draw.

PE: Outdoor Adventurous Activity.

This term we will focus on teamwork and communication through games and orienteering.

Our PE days are Wednesday and Friday.

Science:

For the first term we will explore our changing world and how as human we can have a positive and negative impact on our world. We will then move on to find out about digestion and teeth to help us learn more about our bodies and how to stay healthy.
